Payment Plans and Additional Fees

Tuition is based on 10 months of payments, beginning August 1 and ending May 1, but equally spread between the 4 quarters. • Tuition for each quarter is due 30 days after the quarter starts. Automatic payments will be taken from the account on file with FACTS on the 20th of the following month after the start of the quarter. 4th quarter may incur 'end of year charges/fees' that are due by the Friday before the last day of school. • For all other account types, the monthly tuition will be taken from your account by the FACTS payment program on the date you select. • Families must register with FACTS by August 1st • Annual tuition paid in full will be a \$5 service fee to FACTS. • Semi-Annual payments are paid in August and January with a one time \$25 service fee to FACTS. • Monthly payments begin August 10th and end May 20th with a one-time \$55 service fee to FACTS • Yearbooks, childcare, sports, music and field trips will require additional fees.
