STEP 5—RETURN COMPLETED PACKET

Return the COMPLETED (all requested information must be on file) packet to SWCS. After the administration has had time to review the registration packet, the school office will call the parents/guardians to set up an interview with the school principal. STUDENT(S) MUST BE PRESENT AT THE INTERVIEW.

Following the interview, parents will be notified of an admission decision in a timely manner.

Registration Fees – The registration fee is paid upon submission of application to SWCS and is non-refundable. (See Schedule of Fees.) Checks are made payable to SWCS. Payment of the registration fee will secure your child's class space.

Payment Options:

- 1. Annual tuition paid in full by July 1, 2020, does not require enrollment in the FACTS payment program.
- 2. Monthly Tuition: Tuition is based on 10 monthly payments, beginning August 1, 2020, and ending May 1, 2021. Monthly tuition will be taken from your account by the FACTS payment program on the date you select, either the 10th or the 20th. Families must register with FACTS by July 17, 2020.

WHAT IS SOUTHWESTERN CHRISTIAN SCHOOL?

- * We are a ministry of First Christian Church. We are located within the church building at 3261 S Ave 6E in Yuma, Arizona.
- * A parent participation organization. SWCS has an Advisory Committee that is comprised of parents of children enrolled in the school. Members are appointed and serve as a volunteer body to help in meeting the needs of the school. SWCS also has a Parent/Teacher Organization, which meets monthly. Members and officers are parents of the school. Various areas of the school also have parental participation: art, music, physical education, computers, lunch program, etc.
- * All classes are teacher taught, traditional classrooms, using the A Beka, BJU Press, and Saxxon curriculum.
- * A member of ACSI (Association of Christian Schools International).
- * Each class emphasis is on the basic elements of education. Subjects include: Bible Truths, English, Literature, Spelling, History, Science, Health, Math, Reading and Penmanship. Extra curricular activities offered are: Music, Art, Physical Education, orchestra, and competitive after-school sports. Chapel Services are every Wednesday (Intermediate) and Thursday (Primary) mornings. Each class plans several field trips throughout the year as an extension of the curriculum.
- * Fundraising is an essential part of SWCS. Tuition covers 85% of our operating expenses. SWCS families are required to participate in several fundraisers a year. Each child is responsible to raise \$550 in fundraising yearly. In addition, parental support will be needed in the areas of prayer, discipline, and various events and activities throughout the school year.
- * Admission to SWCS is a privilege. We have an extensive admission policy. Parents and students must meet these requirements to enter SWCS.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe that man was created in the image of God, that he sinned in Adam, and that he is now a sinner by nature and by choice. Man must receive a new nature by faith in Jesus Christ, implanted by the Holy Spirit through the Word of God in order to gain eternal salvation. *Gen.* 1:26-27; Rom. 5:12; John 3:3-7; Eph. 2:1-3; John 5:24; Titus 3:5

We believe that the church is the spiritual body of which Christ is the head. The church is composed of all those who truly believe in Jesus Christ as personal Savior, who are to "Keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.," rising above denominational barriers, loving one another and "holding the truth in love... being held together by that which every joint supplies."

We believe that God wonderfully and immutably creates each person as male or female. These two distinct, complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God. *Gen.* 1:26-27. Rejection of one's biological sex is a rejection of the image of God within that person.

We believe that the term "marriage" has only one meaning: the uniting of one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union, as delineated in Scripture. *Gen. 2:18-25.* We believe that God intends sexual intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other. *I Cor. 6:18; 7:2-5; Heb. 13:4.*

We believe that any form of sexual immorality (including adultery, fornication, homosexual behavior, bisexual conduct, bestiality, incest, and use of pornography) is sinful and offensive to God. *Matt.* 15:18-20; I Cor. 6:9-10.

We believe that in order to preserve the function and integrity of Southwestern Christian School as a local Body of Christ, and to provide a biblical role model to the SWCS students and the community, it is imperative that all persons employed by SWCS in any capacity, or who serve as volunteers, agree to and abide by our Statement of Faith. *Matt. 5:16; Phil. 2:14-16; I Thess. 5:22.*

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COMMITMENT FOR PARENTAL SUPPORT

Christian education involves the whole person; therefore, it is desirable that all elements, which bear on the education of a child, be consistent and properly reinforces one another. Southwestern Christian School was founded to educate the children of Christian parents. - 5. We understand that assessments will be made to cover damage to School/Church property (including breakage of windows, abuse of books, etc.).
- 6. We commit to pray for Southwestern Christian School students, and to be supportive of the FCC leadership, and the SWCS administration, faculty and staff.
- 7. We recognize that private education is in need of strong parental support, including events and activities throughout the school year. We pledge to help the school through our time and efforts.

FINANCIAL COMMITMENT

- 1. We agree to pay the tuition according to the following arrangements, and to <u>conclude all required payments before the last day of school</u>.
- 2. We understand that there will be a fee assessed by FACTS for each payment that does not clear an account.
- 3. We understand that in the event the accounting office has not received any payment within 45 days after the due date, our student(s) may be removed from Southwestern Christian School.
- 4. We agree to pay the balance of our account before requesting transcripts to be released.
- 5. In the event that our account should remain delinquent after the said time in paragraph two and upon the discretion of Southwestern Christian School, our account may be turned over to a professional agency for collection.
- 6. Tuition and fees from the previous year must be paid in full before the student is allowed to register at Southwestern Christian School.
- 7. This document is understood to be legally binding, and we have read and agree to comply with the above commitment.

Computer Use Policy

At Southwestern Christian School technology is to be used for educational purposes that serve the school's mission. Students are expected to use good judgement when working in areas not covered directly by the rules. All students are expected to contribute to a stable and productive computing environment. This Responsible Use Policy is an agreement between you, your parents. Your teachers, and Southwestern Christian School.

The terms computer network, laptops, chromebooks, iPad, etc. refer to all aspects of SWCS owned equipment, hardware software, and subscription based internet resources. Digital cameras, scanners, and other forms of technology are covered by this policy as well. <u>All</u> SWCS computers are considered to be multiuser computers; they share a network and what happens to one computer can affect them all.

General Rules:

- Students do not have an expectation of privacy when using school resources. Laptop lab files and folders will be monitored for unacceptable uses and content.
- Leave no trace when using the labs. That includes leaving the hardware (screen, keyboard, and mouse) and the software (settings, desktop, programs) just as you found them at the start of class. Notify your teacher if you notice changes.
- Downloading audio files, video files or other programs/applications is not allowed except for use in an assignment.
- Playing games, chatting, IM'ing, watching entertainment videos (including YouTube), etc. are not allowed. Teachers may allow watching YouTube for instructional purposes at their discretion. When the internet is in use do not click on offers, ads. Etc. Use for your assignment only.
- Food and drink are not permitted near computers.
- Always log out when you are finished with your computer-if you find someone else's account still logged in at a computer, notify the teacher in charge and wait for their instructions.
- Do not print without permission.
- Save your work in designated spot as required by the teacher.
- Follow copyright laws and give credit to the creator of materials, ideas, pictures, or videos that are used in school projects.
- An Electronic Device User Agreement must be signed and filed with the front office before bringing a personal device to school.
